Incarnation Council #15332 was founded on July 1, 2011, in Sarasota Florida. It is through five key areas of service – faith, community, family, youth, and fellowship – that the Knights of Incarnation Council will truly make a difference and receive their greatest, and most personal rewards.

Faith - Incarnation Council Knights are active in our Parish. They

- serve as Eucharistic Ministers, Ushers, RCIA Leaders and various other ministries.
- conduct Corporate Communion and participate monthly in the Eucharistic Adoration.
- support Incarnation School.
- provide financial support to a Diocese of Venice seminarian.
- recognize our Parish Priests, Deacons and Altar Servers.

Community - Our Council Knights are actively involved in community functions. They

- participate in the weekly Friday Prayer Vigils at the Sarasota Planned Parenthood, the 40 Days for Life Program in October and the Diocese's Annual Prayer Walk in January.
- assist the Incarnation St. Vincent DePaul Society during their annual "School Supply Drive" and "Clothing and Food Drive" for St. Michael's Parish in Wauchula.



- provide volunteer support for Sarasota County's Special Olympics events.
- raise funds to support disabled-related organizations in Sarasota.
- operate a concession stand at Ed Smith Stadium during the Baltimore Orioles Spring Training Baseball to support our various Council activities and charities.
- provide assistance to sick and homebound Knights.

Family - The Incarnation Council is family oriented. They

- organize family dinners, picnics and breakfasts.
- offer Masses for departed Knights and their families.
- sponsor an annual Memorial Mass.

Youth - For our youth, our Council

- conducts various youth programs.
- awards scholarships to Incarnation School students who will attend Cardinal Mooney High School.

Fellowship - We also have some fun. Our socials include ball games, dinners, and parties.
